



Cannabinoid Hemp Product Packaging and Labeling Checklist

Not all cannabinoid hemp products are created equally. Consumers should be aware when purchasing cannabinoid hemp products to look for the following information on the product packaging or label. Products that contain this information are more likely to come from a reputable manufacturer who is following quality controls and consumer safety best practices. The Cannabinoid Hemp Program regulations require the following information. Licensees have until April 25, 2022 to come into compliance with the packaging and labeling requirements.
