**RESOLUTION TO MODIFY CERTAIN REGISTRATION FEES TO BE PAID BY REGISTERED ORGANIZATIONS**

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Article 3 of the Cannabis Law, the Cannabis Control Board (Board) is charged with the responsibility of establishing standards and requirements, promulgating rules and regulations, and overseeing activities related to medical cannabis, including, but not limited to the authority to set fees for the application and registration of registered organizations (“RO”);

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 35 of the Cannabis Law, the Board has authority to set registration fee amounts by regulation;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 113.7(c) of Title 9 of the New York Codes, Rules, and Regulations promulgated by the Board, the registration fee for registered organizations is set at \$200,000, which may be modified by the Board in consideration of the “nature and scope” of the business of the applicant;

**WHEREAS**, the number of certified medical cannabis patients and the sales of cannabis in the medical cannabis program have declined over the past several years with the increased size of the adult-use cannabis program;

**WHEREAS**, the Office of Cannabis Management (“Office”) recommends that given the decline in the medical cannabis program, when a registered organization has previously paid the \$200,000 registration fee under 9 NYCRR 113.7(c) and subsequently applies for renewal of their registration, the registration fee shall be reduced to \$20,000.

**WHEREAS**, the Board agrees with the Office’s recommendation and desires to reduce the registration fee amount contained in 9 NYCRR 113.7(c) for RO registrants applying to renew their registration; therefore, be it,

**RESOLVED**, that the Board hereby reduces the registration fee contained in 9 NYCRR 113.7(c) to \$20,000 for ROs who previously paid the \$200,000 fee and are now applying to renew their RO registration.
