RESOLUTION APPROVING CANNABIS RESEARCH LICENSE ANNUAL REPORT, AND APPROVING CERTAIN CANNABIS RESEARCH LICENSE AMENDMENT REQUESTS

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10(1) of the Cannabis Law, the Cannabis Control Board (Board) has the authority to issue any registration, license or permit;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 38 of the Cannabis Law, the Board established a cannabis research license that permits a licensee to produce, process, purchase and/or possess cannabis for certain research purposes, and the Board promulgated regulations governing these licenses at Part 132 of Title 9 of the New York Codes, Rules and Regulations;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 132.9 of Title 9 of the New York Codes, Rules and Regulations, in order to continue licensed activity, a cannabis research licensee must submit certain information to the Board through the submission of an annual report with the Office of Cannabis Management (Office) for subsequent approval or denial by the Board;

WHEREAS, certain research licensees identified in [Attachment A] have completed such annual report(s) to the satisfaction of the Office;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 13(1) and Section 126 of the Cannabis Law, upon application by a cannabis research licensee, the Board may authorize the amendment of a cannabis research license, in part to allow a licensee to relocate, remove an authorized location, or amend listed research partners, and the Board promulgated regulations governing the amendment of such licenses at Part 132.9(g) of Title 9 of the New York Codes, Rules and Regulations

WHEREAS, certain research licensees identified in [Attachment B] have applied to the Board requesting removal of previously approved site locations and research partners from their license;

WHEREAS, the Office has reviewed the information submitted by certain licensees identified in [Attachment B] seeking license amendments, and recommends to the Board to approve such amendments to previously approved site locations and research partners, and recommends to the Board to approve such amendments as set forth in [Attachment B];

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10(1) of the Cannabis Law, the Chairperson of the Board has made a
